

ERWC Literacy Conference Terms & Conditions

1. Payments

All registrations must be paid by credit card in full at the time of registration. When payment has been received, an email confirmation and a receipt will be sent.

2. Substitutions & Cancellations

No substitution or transfer of registration is allowed. If you find that you cannot attend, please cancel your registration as soon as possible. If you register for the ERWC Literacy Conference and do not attend without canceling your registration, the event fee will not be refunded.

3. Registration Confirmation

Registration confirmation will be sent by email at least seven days prior to the event. Registrants not receiving the registration confirmation should contact the event coordinator.

4. Alterations to Program

The ERWC Literacy Conference committee reserves the right to make alterations to the conference timings, speakers, and program. In the unlikely event of the program being cancelled, a full refund will be made. Liability will be limited to the amount of the fee paid by the registrant.

5. Photography & Filming

By registering for the event, you grant permission to the CSU, its employees and agents, to take and use visual/audio images of you. Visual/audio images are any type of recording, including but not limited to photographs, digital images, drawings, renderings, voices, sounds, video recordings, audio clips or accompanying written descriptions.
